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# Nonviolent Crisis Intervention® Program Training (CPI) Introducing *Nonviolent Crisis Intervention*® Flex



The Flex ON-LINE learning experience - a blended learning course

The Flex experience starts with participants completing an on-line portion of the CPI course, you will need a computer or tablet, internet access, and speakers for this portion (closed caption is available). This on-line course will introduce participants to the basic concepts of *Nonviolent Crisis Intervention training*. Course will take approximately two to four hours, and completion of the require quiz at the end of the course (you may exit the course and resume at any time wherever you left off). During the on-line course, participants will use a downloadable *Learner's Guide* that ushers them through each module of the course. The designated time and location to take this course will be established by district/director's guidelines.

Upon completion of the on-line course, participants then bring their *Learner's Guide* to the assigned one-day WESELPA Certified Instructor classroom session, to review key terms and definitions, apply the models and techniques learned and practice these skills. **The *Learner's Guide* must be presented upon registration at WESELPA, no admittance without it.** At the registration/check-in for the classroom session, participants will receive the **Flex Participant Job Aid**, for use in the instructor classroom training. In the classroom session participants will learn and safely practice any applicable physical disengagement and/or holding skills for managing risk behavior. **Upon passing the classroom training, completing the post-test, and participant evaluation, participants will receive the blue certification CPI card, valid for two years.**

WESELPA does not currently offer a CPI refresher course. Therefore, participants must complete the entire Flex Training program to renew CPI certification. An announcement will be made once a renewal course does become available at WESELPA.

**To register select one of the CPI Flex training dates listed below, and submit your registration on-line through the OMS.** Upon submitting a registration, the participant will then receive a WELCOME email that will include the on-line training module link and instructions on how to first complete the training module. Participants will be given time in advance, to complete the on-line training module PRIOR to attending the selected classroom session.

**Note: West End SELPA will not accept participants from outside of the nine local districts serviced by West End SELPA and/or agencies that are not associated with the West End SELPA into the Nonviolent Crisis Prevention Intervention (CPI) training.** (Note: As of July 1, Ontario-Montclair School District will be considered a single district SELPA, and not eligible for the CPI training offered by West End SELPA)

**Time:** 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Check-in between 8:00-8:30 a.m. Late registrations cannot be accepted)  
***Dress comfortably, closed shoes required - Lunch on your own***

**Where (varies):** WESELPA will be located at the 7<sup>th</sup> Street building thru early Fall, and WEESC (Aspen) late fall

**Participants:** **WESELPA district staff only**, who work with students who exhibit serious behavior problems.

**Registration:** Deadline for registration is 5 working days prior to each training date.

**Fees:** \$40.00 per person, includes the combined on-line module and one-day instructor training.

**Due to the timelines of the on-line module training and one-day classroom instruction, participants are required to attend the scheduled classroom date. Cancellations must be made within 3 working days, and may be only re-scheduled to the next available classroom training date (no later than 60 days), no exceptions.**
