Crisis Prevention Institute-CPI

CPI is an evidence-based program that focuses on the care, welfare, safety, and security of students and staff. This curriculum provides strategies to prevent escalating behaviors to intervene and de-escalate risk behaviors, and to reduce or eliminate the use of restraints.

During the classroom session, participants will receive the CPI Non-violent Crisis Intervention booklet for onthe-job reference information. Participants will learn and safely practice any applicable physical disengagement and/or hold skills. Participants will be forwarded a CPI card upon passing post-test and completing the participant evaluation on the day of the training.

WESELPA will now offer CPI's Refresher Training. This streamlined program is designed to efficiently update previously trained staff with effective techniques, while also offering optional advanced topics for those looking to enhance their knowledge further.

Preliminary Full-day Course



Intended Audience: Staff members obtaining their first CPI Certification or staff members who have previously obtained CPI Certification.

Refresher Training (Half-day Course)



Intended Audience: Staff members who have been CPI certified within the last two years of the training date.
