

Nondiscriminatory and Alternative Assessment (Larry P:) A CHC / Cross Battery / PSW Approach

The Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) mandates nondiscriminatory assessment practices for children of culturally and linguistically diverse (CLD) backgrounds. This becomes particularly important when working considering Larry P. This workshop will review the relevant elements and methods involved in assessing populations from an Alternative Assessment/Cross Battery/Cattell Horn Carroll (CHC)/Pattern Strengths and Weaknesses (PSW) perspective and provide updates with regards to assessment trends. The assessment framework will be presented as a sequenced approach that will guide the school psychologist through the assessment process with consideration of contextual factors. This presentation will be “hands-on” by providing the participant with a case study presentation within a Cross Battery/CHC/PSW framework.
